Notice of Co-option

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that **GWERSYLLT COMMUNITY COUNCIL** intends to co-opt a Member to fill the vacancy that exists in the office of Councillor for the South Ward of the Community of Gwersyllt.

Expressions of interest are being sought from members of the public who meet the following qualifications and are interested in representing their community on the Community Council. You must be a British citizen, an eligible Commonwealth citizen, a citizen of any member state of the European Union or a qualifying foreign citizen and be 18 years of age or over, and meet at least one of the following criteria:

- you are registered as a local government elector for the community of Gwersyllt; or
- you have during the whole of the last 12 months occupied as owner or tenant land or premises in the community; or
- your principal or only place of work during the last 12 months has been in the community; or
- you have during the whole of the last 12 months resided in the community or within 4.8 kilometres of it¹

If you wish to be considered for co-option for the vacant seat or want more information about the role of a Community Councillor please contact me by not later than 5.00 p.m. on Tuesday, 14 June 2022. Expressions of interest in this vacancy will be considered by the Community Council at its meeting on Wednesday, 15 June, when a decision will be made.
